- I/We understand the plot remains the property of the church, however the next of kin of the deceased are responsible for its upkeep.
- I/We are aware that a memorial can be placed at the head of the plot after a period of time to allow the ground to settle. Full details of the size and style of memorial can be found in the churchyard regulations.
- I/We understand and agree that if the memorial becomes insecure and unsafe the memorial may be laid flat immediately in order to avoid the risk of injury and damage.
- I/We understand that I am/we are the owners of the memorial and are responsible for its security and safety.
- I/We consent to our names and personal details provided on this form being recorded in the Church records (paper filing system or electronic database) for the purpose of future contact regarding the grave plot.
- Written approval must be obtained from the Vicar or Churchwardens for the design of any memorial prior to entering into a contract with the monumental mason.
